January 20, 2026

The City Council of Audubon Park held a meeting on Tuesday, January 20, 2026. The following were present Mayor Madeline Bozeman, City Clerk Cecilia Niemann, Councilors Austin Schwenker, Brenda Hartman, Joe Tronzo, Nicholas Abel, and Pete Becker. Councilor Joe Brenner was absent.

Call to Order
