

Council Meeting Minutes

December 15, 2025

The City Council of Audubon Park held a meeting on Monday, December 15, 2025. The following were present Mayor Madeline Bozeman, City Clerk Cecilia Niemann, Councilors Brenda Hartman, Joe Brenner, Joe Tronzo, and Nicholas Abel. Councilors Austin Schwenker and Pete Becker were absent.

Call to Order

Mayor Bozeman called the meeting to order at 6:00PM.

Public Comments

Jason Cebe asked if any decision was made regarding the issue with the camper next door to him. The mayor stated that the attorney informed her if Code Enforcement didn't find that it in violation, it's up to the Council to draft a new ordinance. The conversation continued.

The water was shut off in Cross Bill Park due to a leak. The Mayor recommended the water be shut off in all the parks to be safe. As of right now, there is no water in the parks to prevent any freezing or bursting pipes.

Santa's Sled is still in progress. Candy Canes were ordered to be given out during his visit.

Thanks to the Council for handling last month's meeting without the Mayor and for the moment of silence for those affected by the UPS plane crash. The Chili and Cornbread Cookoff raised double the amount of money from last year, a timely donation to the UofL Burn Center for some of the costs associated with the victims of the plane crash.


Public Comments

Nancy Heine asked if garbage is supposed to be picked up on Christmas Eve. The Mayor stated that it was supposed to be picked up since Christmas Eve isn't a holiday for Waste Management. Nancy Heine commented on the City's marvelous job plowing the streets during the snowy weather.
