

Council Meeting Minutes

November 17, 2025

The City Council of Audubon Park held a meeting on Monday, November 17, 2025. The following were present City Clerk Cecilia Niemann, Councilors Austin Schwenker, Brenda Hartman, Joe Brenner, Joe Tronzo, and Nicholas Abel. Mayor Madeline Bozeman and Councilor Pete Becker were absent.

Call to Order

Councilor Schwenker called the meeting to order at 6:00PM.

Councilor Schwenker asked for a moment of personal prayer and silence for those impacted by the UPS plane crash. He invited Sgts Barto and Sturgeon to the floor and read the memorandum they wrote to the mayor. The memorandum recommended the Mayor's Medal of Valor to be awarded to Police Chief Murdoch for his immediate response to the scene of the UPS plane crash.

Mayor Bozeman's Pride of Place Update

Councilor Schwenker gave the floor to Pete Hall. They raised around \$20,000 for the stage, halfway to the end goal of \$40,000. Construction is slower than expected, but the foundation is complete. Realm Construction has agreed to move the rest of the base material from the condos for building.

About 150 feet of sidewalk was replaced the past week with about 40 feet of curb and gutter.

There has been steady clean up in the parks because of falling leaves.
