

CODE ENFORCEMENT REPORT

This is a brief review for February code enforcement activities. Off Duty consultations totaled three calls this month. Picked up trash in parks on two days. There were eight consultations conducted this month. Cleaned up Preston entrance. Worked on removing emergency equipment from police car on three shifts.
