The City Council of Audubon Park held a meeting Monday, May 12, 2025. The following were present Mayor Madeline Bozeman, City Clerk Cecilia Niemann, Councilors Austin Schwenker, Brenda Hartman, Joe Brenner, Joe Tronzo, and Olivia Powell. Councilor Pete Becker was absent.

## Call to Order

The mayor called the meeting to order at 7:27PM.

## Public Comments

## New Business

Mayor Bozeman asked for motion to bring Ordinance 5, Series 2025 to the floor. Councilor Brenner made a motion; Councilor Tronzo seconded. Councilor Powell read the ordinance. All were in favor, Councilor Becker absent.
