

# Council Meeting Minutes

July 21, 2025

The City Council of Audubon Park held a meeting Monday, July 21, 2025. The following were present Mayor Madeline Bozeman, City Clerk Cecilia Niemann, Councilors Austin Schwenker, Brenda Hartman, Joe Brenner, Joe Tronzo, and Pete Becker. Councilor Olivia Powell was absent.

## Call to Order

Mayor Bozeman called the meeting to order at 6:00PM.

## Public Comments

Lane Davis, the Public Affairs Specialist with the U.S. Small Business Administration Office of Recovery, addressed the Council with his presentation regarding disaster recovery loans.
