ORDINANCE 5, SERIES 2025**

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE DISPOSAL OF YARD WASTE IN PUBLIC
RIGHT OF WAYS**

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBERS POWELL & SCHWENKER

WHEREAS, the City of Audubon Park is committed to maintaining clean, safe, and visually appealing public spaces for all residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the improper disposal of yard waste such as leaves, grass clippings, vegetation, and other debris into public streets, sidewalks, and storm drains contribute to flooding, clogs infrastructure, and creates public nuisances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF AUDUBON PARK, KENTUCKY:


1) Chapter 92 of Title IX of the Code of Ordinances of the City is hereby amended to add new subsection to section 92.01 to read as follows:

(V) Prohibited Disposal Practices

- 1) It shall be unlawful for any person to blow, rake, sweep, or otherwise deposit leaves, grass clippings, or other yard debris onto public streets, sidewalks, storm drains, or other public rights-of-way within the City of Audubon Park.
 - 2) If any section, clause, sentence, or provision of this ordinance is found to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
- 2) Any portion of the Code of Ordinances of the City in conflict with paragraph (1) above is hereby repealed.
 - 3) This Ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage, signing, and publication as required by law.

This Ordinance was passed and adopted at a meeting of the City Council of the City of Audubon Park Kentucky held on the 16th day of June 2025 having first been read at a meeting held on the 12th day of May 2025.
